This project is presented in the framework of the Erasmus+ - Education programme, specifically Key Action 2 – cooperation in innovation and exchange of practice, KA201 – strategic partnerships in school education.

Name of the presented project

« Looks on the world »

Project duration

The project is scheduled to run for 3 years. It starts in September 2019 and ends in August 2022.

Description of the project

In a context of dropping out of school which affects all social categories in the European countries and which affects young people from low-income and low-cultural families, such as the children of immigrants and refugees, much more significantly. Education systems need to adopt new pedagogical strategies with intercultural dialogue as their main vector.

The association Annaba supported by the services of National Education since 2003 and by the agency Erasmus Education & Training since 2017, leads with educational institutions, municipalities, cultural structures, various educational, artistic and cultural experiences, intended to support the teaching work of teachers.

“Looking at the world” approaches fundamental knowledge in another way, values the diversity of cultures of many disadvantaged children and immigrants. It favours multiple modes of expression to favour intercultural dialogue.

The project has two objectives, on the one hand to alleviate the dropping out of school of disadvantaged and multicultural audiences, and on the other hand, to develop key skills through intercultural dialogue involving target audiences: students, teachers, and families.

At a time when Europe welcomes an unprecedented number of migrants and refugees, one of the major European priorities is to support the transnational character of project promoters by strengthening the synergy and interaction of the skills of each to put pupils, families in a position of confidence and success.

The transnational nature of the project is a priority. It plays a major role because it encourages mutual understanding between the peoples of the countries of the world, it makes it possible to demonstrate the real contributions of intercultural dialogue and to project in the medium term on common objectives.

The stages of the project

2019/2020 "Training – Mobility Action"

Beneficiary education actors are trained in the tools of the project. The training will be organized in 4 5-day seminars. They are distributed from November 2019 to July 2020.

2020/2021 "Implementation of the project with the classes"

Education actors will apply the project in the classroom in collaboration with the arts team of the coordinating body and the associated partners.

2021/2022 "Evaluation and Mobility Dissemination"

A conference-debate will be held in each country, inviting education professionals, families, childcare professionals, researchers, etc.

The beneficiaries

Educational institutions for pupils aged 6 to 12.

The partnerships sought have had a significant influx of refugee demand since 2015: France, Germany, Sweden, Norway, Spain, Greece, Belgium, Italy, Portugal, Austria.
